That funding be sought to resurface the L4211-2 from the Cross of the Tree to Cooney's, part of this road is classified "Red" and badly needs attention.

5.2 Cllr. Michael Fitzgerald (Ref. ID 2661)

That part of the road known as the Fourpenny Road, Golden be included for any extra funding in 2023-24.

5.3 Cllr. Michael Fitzgerald (Ref. ID 2662)

That this Municipal Authority seek an urgent meeting with the T.I.I to discuss the serious amount of accidents on the N24 between Tipperary Town and the county bounds just after Monard. The residents should also be involved in any meeting that is hopefully called.

Limerick Junction and Monard at Ballykisteen. This is a dangerous stretch of road with multiple collisions and fatalities in recent years. This council should explore every possibility available to make this stretch of road safer for road users and for local residents.

That this council would remove the tree and section of built out footpath outside 38 Pearse Park to allow for extra residential parking spaces. The area is full of cars and there aren't nearly enough parking spaces.

That this council would explore the possibility of providing traffic calming measures on the stretch of road outside Shronell National School. The speed limit is quite high for a stretch of road outside a school. Traffic calming measures would ensure safer access to the school for students, parents and staff.

That this Council secure without delay the funds to put in place a Bigbelly Waste Bin in the villages of Ardfinnan and Ballyporeen.
