Three years ago our hall had died and now it's been brought back to life!

Boher was fortunate to have its Parish Hall designated as a Broadband Connection Point (BCP). The BCP is part of the connected hubs and it has three hot desks available for remote workers. The BCP has provided opportunities for Boher to work in collaboration with Trinity College, Our Kids Code and Microsoft to deliver weekly inclusive family coding meet ups. A long term coding club has now been established. The hall is


currently facilitating Smartphone courses for older people and farmers which are being delivered by Tipperary ETB. It is a thriving community hub that is being widely used by the Boher community and surrounds.



Boher BCP launched Dream Space™ nationally. The programme engaged a wide range of stakeholders, including Microsoft Dream Space, Microsoft Ireland's STEM innovation and education programme, OurKidsCode, the Department of Rural and Community Development, Tipperary County Council and participating schools and clubs. This collaborative effort demonstrated a unique and sustainable way of engaging the local community in digital education.

Simon Howe Broadband Officer sees this evidenced in particular in rural Ireland and states that "Tipperary's Boher BCP is a perfect example of how community engagement through volunteers energises a local community to promote digital literacy and community development".
