25 groups in County Tipperary receiving grant assistance of €750,000 from the Community Climate Action Fund

Tipperary County Council has received approval from the Minister of the Environment, Climate & Communications to provide €750,000 grant assistance to 25 projects in the county under the terms of the Community Climate Action Fund.

“There was huge interest in the funding Call within County Tipperary”, said Cllr. Declan Burgess, Cathaoirleach of Tipperary County Council. Cllr. Burgess continued “the Council received 82 applications with total project costs in excess of four times the funding available and undertook a rigorous assessment process with each application received being examined in detail.

A list of the successful applicants is attached.

The Community Climate Action Officer for Tipperary County Council looks forward to engaging further with the successful groups as they enter in to the contracting stage of their respective project. The Community Climate Action Officer also looks forward to working with groups that were unsuccessful on this occasion to assist them with applications for the next tranche of funding, which will be dependent on Departmental approval but should take place in the near future.

“I am delighted to see so many local voluntary community groups taking part in this programme for climate action. Building low carbon communities is a very positive step for our county in reaching our ambitious targets that were set out in our recently adopted Tipperary County Council Climate Action Plan 2024 – 2029”, stated Cllr. Declan Burgess stated.
