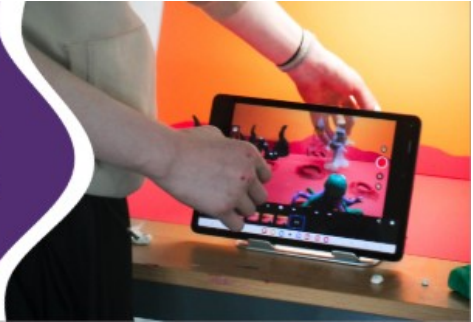

Let's Animate! A Stop-Motion Animation Workshop

Date: Tuesday, 12th November, 2024

Time: 9.30 – 1.30

Venue: Templemore College of Further Education, Templemore, Co Tipperary

Join the Tipperary Youth Arts Hub and artist Mike Byrne for a stop-motion animation workshop!

This exciting workshop with the Tipperary Youth Arts Hub is a fun, hands-on introduction to the techniques involved in creating stop-motion animated films. Working with artist Mike Byrne, we'll explore the wonder of stop-motion animation, build our basic skills, develop a story/concept and turn it into a short, animated film! So, let's animate and find new, creative ways to support young people to voice the stories they want to tell!

During this workshop together, we will:

- Explore basic stop-motion animation skills using plasticine, wires, paper, Lego and other materials
- Work together in groups to explore a theme, develop a story/concept and make a storyboard for our animation projects
- Try our hands at using stop-motion apps, editing and adding voice-overs to enhance your animation
- Experience facilitation approaches and ideas to help us use stop-motion animation in youth work and youth arts practice

Open Call for Light Based Artworks Longford Lights 2025

Deadline for submissions Friday 25th October 2024

Longford Lights Festival Thursday Feb 20th - Sunday Feb 23rd

Installation of inside artwork Mon 3rd to Friday 7th Feb

Longford Lights is a light festival held at the end of February. In 2024 it attracted over 12000 people over 3 nights. The ethos is one of social engagement and participation, and we particularly welcome proposals with a participatory or interactive element, though it is not essential.

While primarily a lantern festival, the Open Call is the opportunity to add exciting, surprising light-based work to enrich the experience. This can be indoor or outdoor installations or performance.

The main site, at the former Connolly Barracks is self-contained, with grass areas and a paved route. There is a series of indoor rooms in the building that we will be using and an indoor/ outdoor space in the old Market House. For 2025 we are extending into the town from the barracks. We are looking for a variety of scales of work. To facilitate the site build we are requesting an early install in the first week of February for indoor work

We have a limited crew and will provide assistance but expect the artist to manage all technical aspects of the install.

Budget for existing work €500 - €1500

We may award up to 2 commissions for creation of new work to a maximum value of €2500

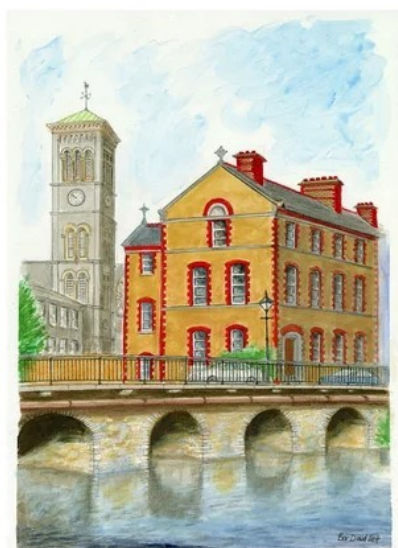

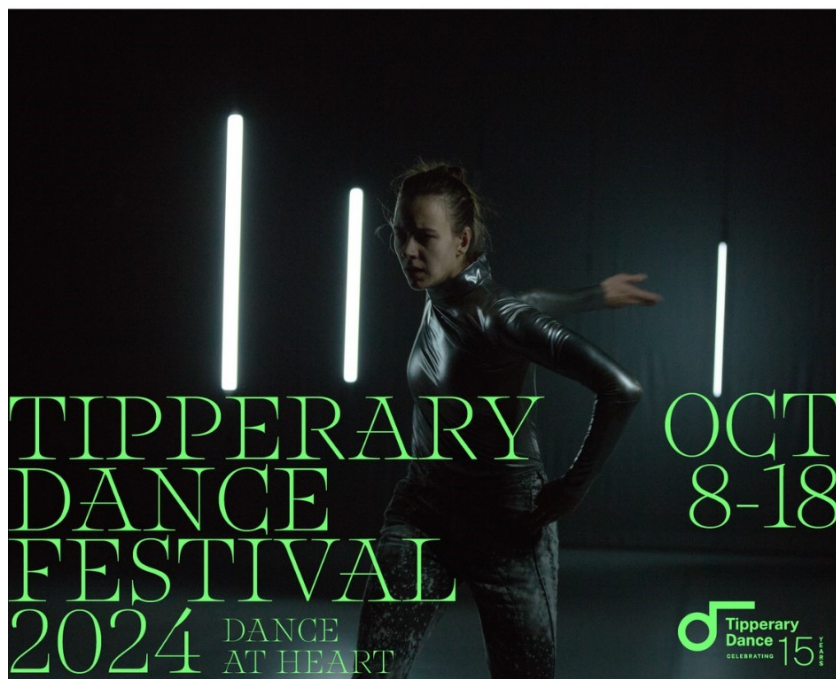
