"That with the agreement of the elected members that the Thurles Municipal District would write to Uisce Eireann and express the serious concerns that exist in relation to the reliability of the water

supply in Gortnahoe & Ballysloe which are serviced by the Killenaule supply and also in rural areas such as Clonamicklon, Kilbraugh and Foilacam which are serviced by the Coolbrook supply.

Over the last two months the supply on both lines has broken down on several occasions leaving residents without supply for days and with very low water pressure on a number of occasions"
