

## Bursary to attend the BLAS INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL FOR TRADITIONAL IRISH MUSIC AND DANCE

## **Conditions of the Scheme:**

- ❖ Tipperary County Council is offering two bursaries to attend this year's summer school at the University of Limerick. The value of the bursary covers 1 week's tuition (one-week intensive of masterclasses, Irish language, lectures and concerts). The purpose of these bursaries is to support professional development of artists.
- ❖ Applicants must be resident in the Tipperary administrative area.
- ❖ Applicants must have achieved intermediate level of proficiency in their chosen area at a minimum e.g. (music/song/dance).
- ❖ Payment of the bursaries will be made directly to the Blas International Summer School of Irish Traditional Music and Dance.
- ❖ Applicants must be age 18 years (by 1<sup>st</sup> June 2026).
